First Lithium Concentrate at Altura Lithium Project

The first batch of lithium concentrate was produced in July 2018 at Altura Pilgangoora Lithium Mine. This milestone comes 16 months since first ground was broken at Pilgangoora in mid-March 2017.

The results for the first product have shown a concentrate product grade meeting the industry benchmark SC6 specifications and those required by offtake partners.

The Altura Team is now looking forward to the next milestone of haulage of product to the Qube facility in Wedgefield, and then followed by first shipment of product shortly afterwards.
